Official Rules

1. **Restricted Categories:** An invigilator will be used for all restricted categories and closed divisions.
2. **Solo Exhibition, Cabaret & Formation:** No solo exhibition is to exceed 2½ minutes (2:30). Music must be on CD's or thumb drive. Critique and Score will be given on Solo Exhibition Routines.
3. **Pro/Am Senior 3 dance challenge competitions.** Open to Pro/Am Couples. Amateur must be at least 60 years old. These will be unisex events.
4. **Pro/Am One Dance Championships** are offered in Bronze, Silver and Gold. These will be unisex events.
5. **Pro/Am Scholarships:** These are unisex competitions **with 3 age divisions**. A minimum of 5 single dance Freestyle entries must be entered in the same style & level in order to qualify for each scholarship entered. Students may NOT enter both Bronze & Silver levels in the same style. Students MAY enter both the Silver & the Open scholarships in the same style. Students must enter the scholarship level of the highest single dance entry level in a style. For example: If a student enters single dance entries in Full Bronze and Pre-Silver they would be eligible for the Silver Scholarship NOT the Bronze Scholarship in that style. All Pro/Am Scholarship Prize Money will automatically be awarded to the Amateur unless otherwise instructed. If fewer than 3 couples entered in any scholarships event the prize money will be reduced by ½ of the above amounts.
6. **Global Closed Scholarships:** Restricted to Bronze & Silver students only. These are unisex competitions. A minimum of 5 single dance entries must be entered in the same style & level in order to qualify for each scholarship. If fewer than 3 couples entered in any scholarships event the prize money will be reduced by ½ of the above amounts.
7. **Global Senior Championships:** Competitors must be at least 60 years old. These are unisex competitions. A minimum of 5 single dance entries must be entered in the same style & level in order to qualify for each scholarship. If fewer than 3 couples entered in any scholarships event the prize money will be reduced by ½ of the above amounts.
8. **Level & Age restrictions:** In CLOSED divisions of "Pro/Am Single Dance Freestyle Competitions" Pro/Am Student Dancers may enter a maximum of three (3) consecutive skill levels. Students may compete in no more than 2 age levels. In OPEN divisions of "Pro/Am Single Dance Freestyle Competitions" Pro/Am student dancers may enter as many skill levels as they wish. Students may submit entries in completely different levels in the different dance styles. For example: American Open Gold Foxtrot and International Beginner Bronze Foxtrot.
9. **Amateur Events:** Syllabus Amateur couples are restricted to syllabus material (Bronze or Silver). Costumes are NOT ALLOWED. There are no restrictions in the Adult Amateur Novice, Pre-Champ or Championship divisions.
10. **Top Teacher Awards:** To qualify a teacher must submit a minimum of 75 entries. Point System: Refer to the World Pro/Am Dancesport Series Rules at www.dancesportseries.com for complete details. Amateur Couple entries in Multi dance competitions do **NOT** count toward any Top Teacher prizes or bonuses. Student/Student Freestyle and Solo Entries **DO NOT** count toward Top Teacher awards however they WILL count for Top Teacher Bonus Money. All entries must be paid in full and danced to count toward Top Teacher. Points Tables: Any discounted entry (Jr. & Youth) and uncontested entries will be 1/2 points.

11. **Top Teacher Bonus rules:** This money is paid in ADDITION to any Top Teacher Prize Money. Any Professional who enters and dances pro/am or has student/student single dance freestyle entries will be paid according to the bonus money schedule as stated in the brochure.
12. **Entry Deadline:** The organizers cannot accept responsibility for accuracy of entries submitted after the deadline date. Any payments made after the deadline must be in the form of cash, cashiers check or money order or credit card.
13. **Cancellations & Refunds:** The deadline for cancellation refunds without penalty is two (2) weeks prior to the event. A letter requesting refund of payments must follow cancellations. All refunds will be made 30 days following the event. No refunds will be made if cancellation is made within two (2) weeks of the event. Cancelled entries taken at the event cannot be substituted by another entry. There are no refunds or exchanges on general admission tickets.
14. **Registration Requirements:** All Professional competitors and Amateur Novice, Pre-Champ and Championship competitors are required to register with the National Dance Council of America (NDCA). 15. **Late Entries:** DEADLINE is May 14, 2011 – Entries submitted after the deadline will be accepted on a space available basis.
